Overview

The Global Energy Parliament (GEP) is an international body working for science, sustainability, and peace, founded by His Holiness Jagadguru Swami Isa. GEP is organized by the Isa Viswa Prajnana Trust, a registered charitable organization holding Consultative Status to the United Nations' Economic and Social Council. Since 2010 GEP has organized annual international sessions of parliament to collaborate on innovative solutions to the most pressing issues facing the world.

What We Do

The Parliament

The Global Energy Parliament is the first and only global parliament, designed for all human beings to become Members who feel a responsibility to the world and its inhabitants.

The Parliament meets once a year in a different place in the world, in which Members assemble to discuss the present challenges facing life on Earth.

Discussions are held, Bills and Resolutions are passed in a spirit of harmony, peace and unity. There are no politics in this Parliament. The Parliament is chaired by the Speaker. The Ministers appointed are global experts in their fields.

The Secretariat

The GEP Secretariat is located in Thiruvananthapuram, India and oversees the communication of the Resolutions and Acts of Parliament to the world's governments and international agencies.

The Research Centre

The GEP Research Centre (GEPRC) is a research and development organization supporting an international network of researchers and projects on the global forefront of the science of energy.

National Centres

GEP National Centres are registered in a number of countries, where Members of Parliament conduct various activities in society to advance GEP's knowledge and solutions, such as fruit tree planting, yoga classes, teacher education, book publication, and National Energy Parliaments.



Major Contributions

The I-Theory

The greatest contribution of the Global Energy Parliament is its foundational theory called the I-Theory, which was introduced by the Founder, His Holiness Jagadguru Swami Isa at the maiden session of the GEP.

The I-Theory is a 'theory of everything' that can unify disparate streams of knowledge into one, at the same time as it significantly advances science to new frontiers. It proposes the 'I-particle' as the fundamental particle of all matter and energy, a tiny unit of vibration.



Understanding the mechanisms of the I-particle and its arrangements from the quantum to the cosmic level, is the key to understanding the laws of natural balance.

In the GEP, a problem is analysed for which specific type of energy imbalance is exhibited, and a solution is proposed to re-balance without disturbing the balance at any other level. This is true sustainability.

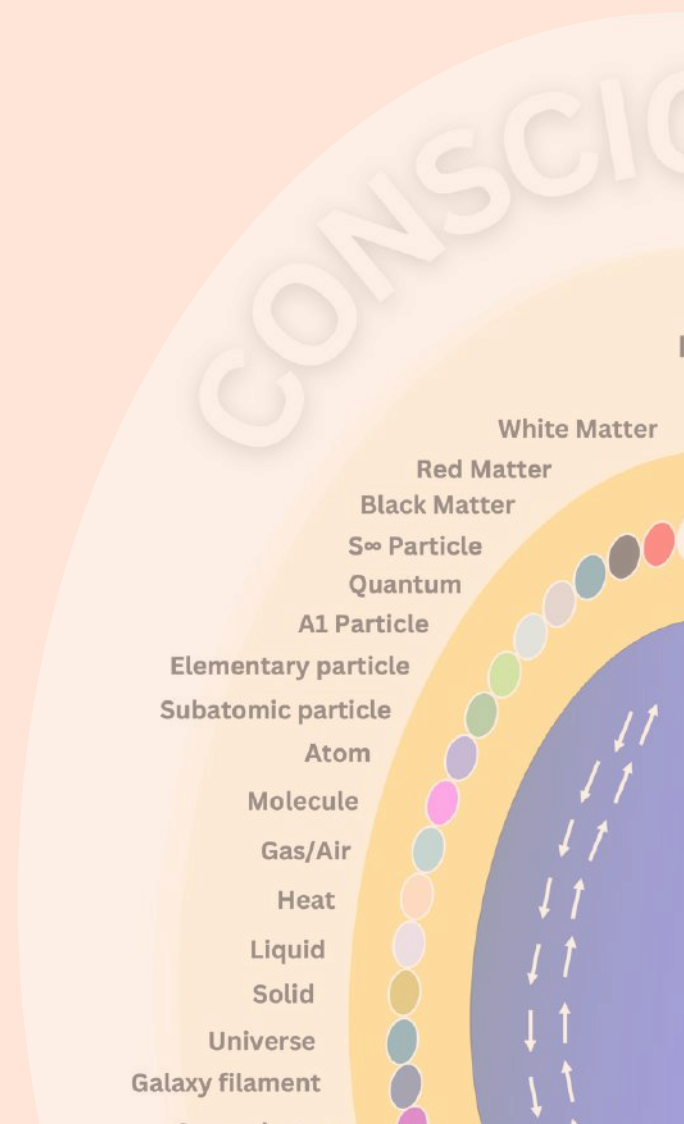


Every year, I-Theory based approaches to solving global problems are presented, discussed and voted on in Parliament. The passed Acts and Resolutions are submitted to national governments and international organizations.

The GEP's unique approach is to look at problems in such depth and at the same time with as broad a view--from the universe to the tiniest particle. In the same way, we seek solutions addressing the root causes of problems, and favour long-term solutions rather than fast but unsustainable ones.

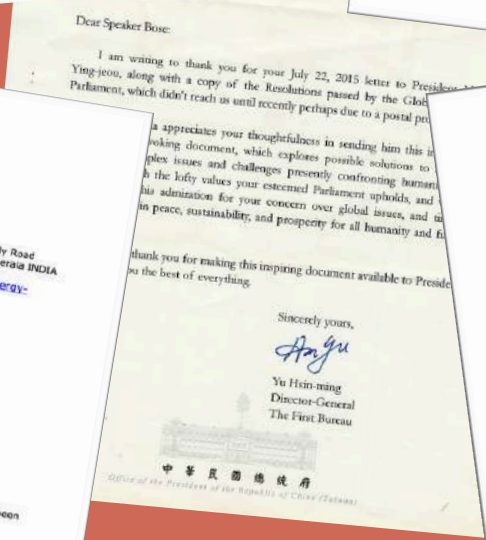
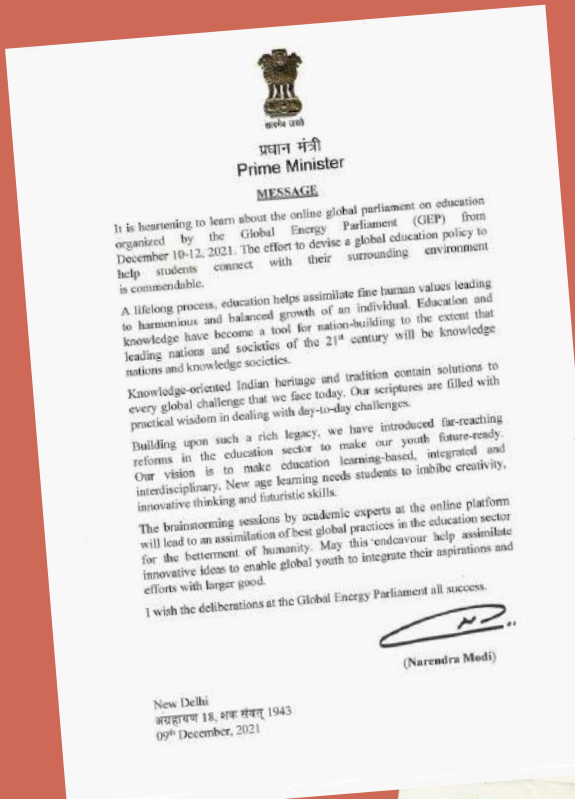

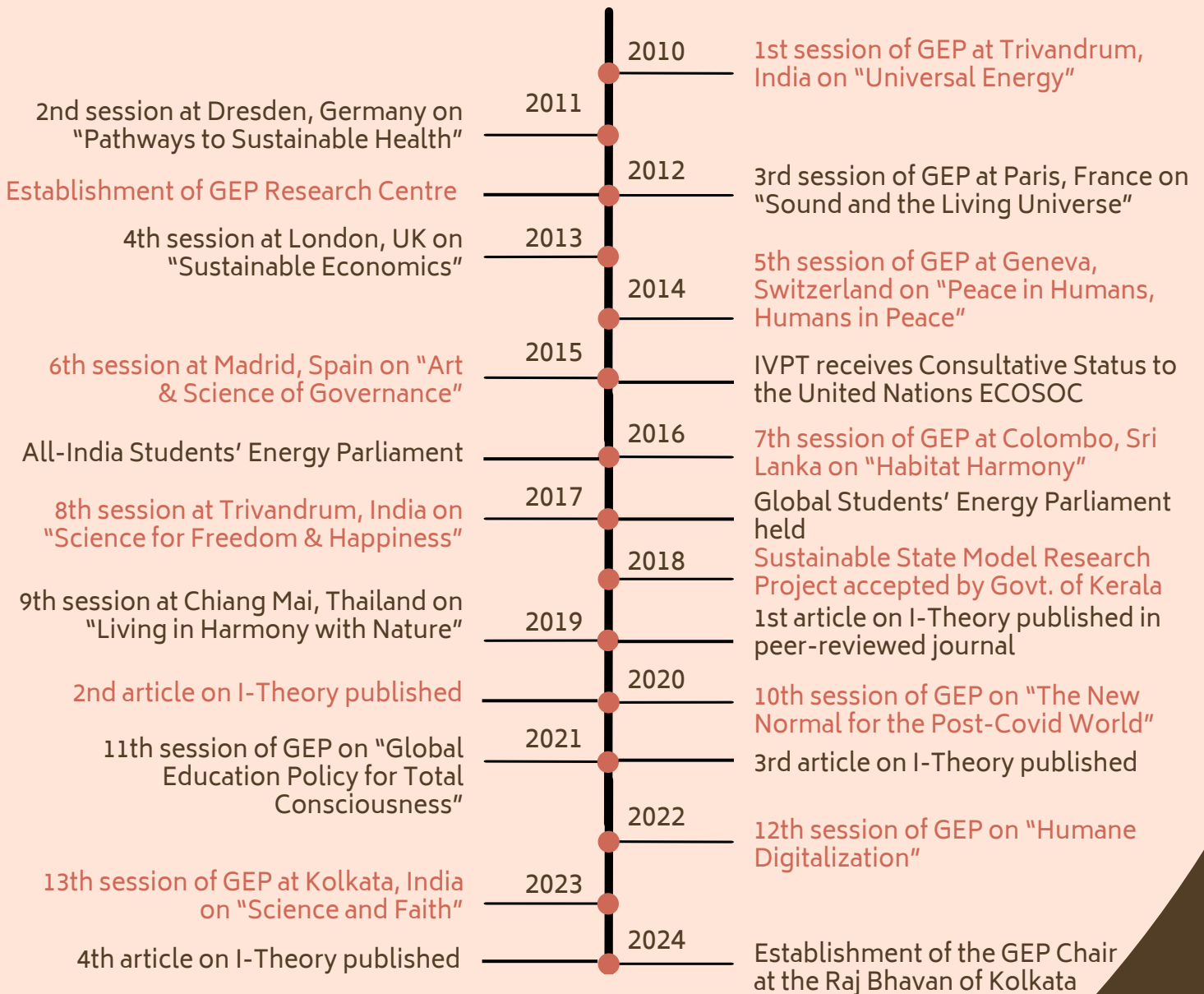

Our Founder

His Holiness Jagadguru Swami Isa



His Holiness Jagadguru Swami Isa is a teacher, scientist and social reformer, whose vision is to create a world where every human being can attain total happiness, or Total Consciousness. Swami Isa is author of numerous books and articles ranging from education to physics to economy, and has been published in peer-reviewed journals for physics and medicine.

Swami Isa is known for his theory of everything called the I-Theory, his system of education called Education for Total Consciousness, and his Life for Total Consciousness yoga system.

To share his ideas with society, Swami Isa founded the charitable Isa Viswa Prajnana Trust (holding Consultative Status to the United Nations ECOSOC), the Global Energy Parliament, the GEP Research Centre, the Isa Viswa Vidyalayam school, and the Isalayam Ashram. These institutions conduct an array of formal and informal educational programs including conferences and seminars, teacher training, yoga teacher training, and cultural talks and programmes.

Swami Isa lives in his ashram, Isalayam, in Kerala, India and travels worldwide to share his teachings.

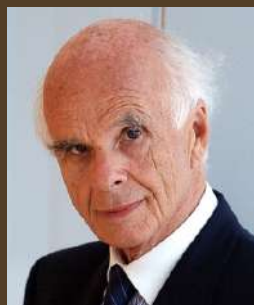
